Mission and Vision

At Smile Back Foundation, our mission is to support full-mouth restorations and promote dental health and education in those who need it most. We believe that everyone deserves a healthy smile, regardless of their economic or geographic circumstances. Our vision is a world where preventable dental suffering is eliminated, where access to expert surgical care is available to all, and where oral health is recognized not just as a matter of appearance, but as fundamental to one's overall well-being and quality of life.

Programs and Services

Smile Back runs multiple connected initiatives aimed at delivering comprehensive dental care and raising awareness:

- **Pro Bono Full-Mouth Restorations**: We partner with the world's top oral and head and neck surgeons to provide pro bono surgery to patients who cannot afford life-changing operations. These surgeries are life-changing, and often address severe dental disease, trauma, or neglect.
- **Cleft and Craniofacial Clinic**: We launched this clinic with a lip reconstruction case for an infant boy in 2024.
- **Dental Health and Education**: Alongside surgical interventions, we emphasize preventive education—teaching patients and communities about oral hygiene, disease prevention, and maintaining dental health over time.
- **Outreach and Partnerships**: We collaborate with local and international partners to identify cases where our surgical interventions can have maximal positive impact. Our outreach work helps ensure that those in need discover Smile Back, that barriers to care are reduced, and that long-term dental health is supported.

Impact and Outcomes

Over the past year, Smile Back Foundation has:

- Supported numerous full-mouth restoration surgeries administered by top dental surgeons, enabling patients to regain functional teeth, oral comfort, nutrition, and self-confidence.
- Expanded our volunteer network (surgeons, dental professionals, educators), strengthening capacity to serve more people in more places.
